	Vocabulary Requirement	CEFR	Communicative Goals
HSK 6	5000 or more	C2	can easily comprehend written and spoken information in Chinese and can effectively express themselves in Chinese, both orally and on paper.
HSK 5	2500	C1	can read Chinese newspapers and magazines, enjoy Chinese films and plays and give a full-length speech in Chinese.
HSK 4	1200	B2	can converse in Chinese on a wide range of topics and are able to communicate fluently with native Chinese speakers.
HSK 3	600	B1	can communicate in Chinese at a basic level in daily lives and manage most communication in Chinese when travelling in China.
HSK 2	300	A2	excellent grasp of basic Chinese and can communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information.
HSK 1	150	A1	can understand and use very simple Chinese phrases, meet basic needs for communication.
